With no telephones,

internet, or roads, the mission plane is a vital lifeline for Amerindians living in these remote jungle villages in Western Guyana. I picked up this toddler and her mother with the plane two hours after the radio call came in. First, we flew to the regional clinic downriver, doing in twenty minutes what would have taken all day in the boat. Once at the clinic, the toddler was quickly assessed and referred on to Georgetown. There she could receive treatment at a better equipped facility.

In a few short days I would fly this mom and her little girl back to their village. In a few short years adult teeth would replace the gaps in her mouth. The only records of the incident would be fading memories and an entry in my logbook.
