They have told us that we must have \$7000 American dollars to be paid

before the container can be released. The longer that container sets in port the more additional charges will be incurred.

Please pray with us that the Lord will provide the way to get the container released. We serve a wonderful heavenly Father! It is His work and He is the reason that it can move forward, but we are to seek and knock and ask.

We would be comforted to know that our brothers and sisters in faith are praying with us about this mountain in our path, that it might no longer block our forward travel!





Pay off the \$7000 USD duty charge for getting the container released from the port of Belize so we can use the equipment.

To put up the next 3 buildings we are waiting for \$6000 to buy foam for the walls. We have all the metal we need for the structures to go up.
